The Decero™ Design Team was inspired by the rich Tuscan-inspired office development featuring iron details, warm hues, and twisting grandfather oaks. The boardwalk's design is infused with a burnt red, crisp almond, pine green, and pops of black iron throughout embracing walkers with a vibrant glow. Covered gathering spaces are sprinkled amongst the meandering walkway, one featuring a clay tiled roof and custom iron work framing views of lush ferns and a small pond. The Repetitive Span bridge was built utilizing the industry-unique and eco-friendly top down YBC construction method to minimize impacts within the sensitive wetlands.

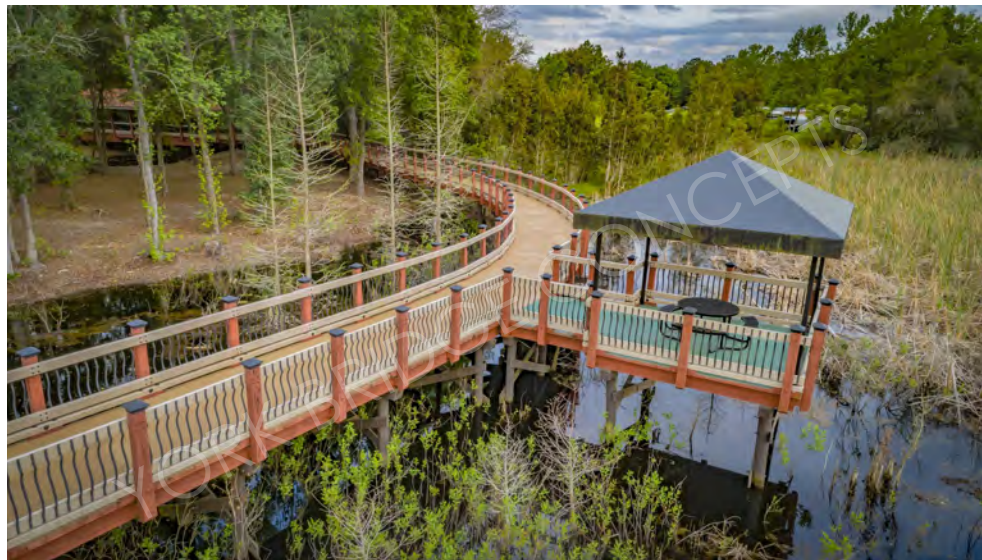
